Integrating Flipgrid to Canvas

Instructions on how to integrate the Flipgrid video discussion application to an individual Canvas course.

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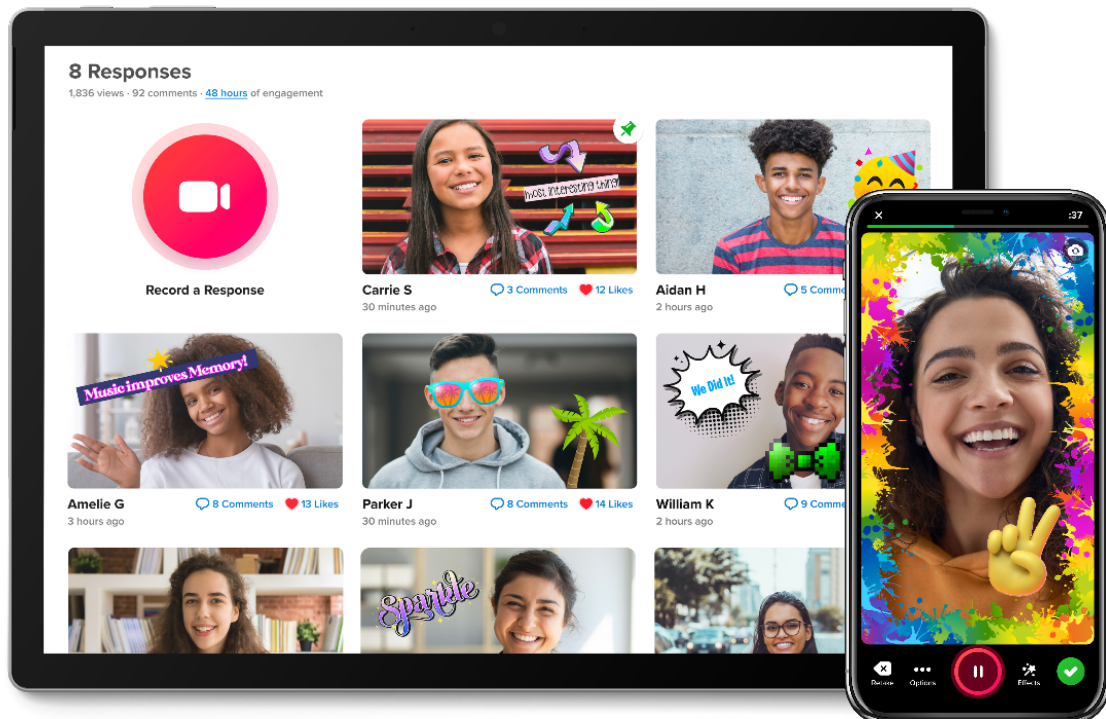


What is Flipgrid?

Flipgrid is a free and simple tool that allows instructors to facilitate video discussions within their classrooms. For distance learning or fully online courses in which students rarely meet face-to-face, Flipgrid proves especially useful for fostering relationships between students and their instructors. Students can easily communicate with one another in a course through Flipgrid's intuitive design and easy to use video recording and editing tools. Flipgrid is a web-based application, which ensures that students and instructors can participate anywhere with an internet connection using any device that has a camera and microphone.

Once an account is created, it is simple for an instructor to set up discussions for their students. Instructors can create "grids" to house their students and discussion prompts. Once a grid is created, the instructor then poses discussion prompts in the form of "topics" to their students. Students assigned to a grid can then navigate to the topic, record their response, and reply to other classmates who are members of the grid.

Since Flipgrid has been adapted to be used in all classrooms from kindergarten to higher education, it can be integrated with a number of learning services, including the Canvas learning management system. Flipgrid operates seamlessly when integrated with Canvas, but only if instructors follow a series of steps and procedures. In this manual, you will be walked through each step of this process and will be given resources for additional learning. If you have any additional questions, please reach out to your college's instructional designer or IT department.

Flipgrid

Canvas is the LMS that makes teaching and learning easier. Flipgrid is the video discussion platform that makes teaching and learning more personal, fun, and engaging. Integrate the two platforms seamlessly with Flipgrid's Canvas integration!

- **Canvas Access Control** - Only students in your Canvas course can access your connected Grids. Students can still join on mobile but must start within the Canvas app.
- **SpeedGrader** - Add a Flipgrid Topic for your next Canvas Assignment. Student videos automatically show up in SpeedGrader.
- **Anywhere, Anytime** - As long as students click the green + within Canvas, they can record on any computer or on the free Flipgrid iOS + Android apps.

Flipgrid does not support admin or account-level setup. Additionally, existing Groups and Topics cannot be integrated. Instead, teachers need to setup their own integrations and it will create a new Group & Topics for each course.

To use the Flipgrid Canvas integration, educators must first have a Flipgrid account. Visit admin.flipgrid.com to login or create your 100% free educator account.

In this section, we will review

1. Signing up and signing in to Flipgrid.
2. Creating an integration code to add the Flipgrid application to your course.
3. Editing a Canvas assignment to accept Flipgrid submissions.

By integrating the Flipgrid application with your Canvas course, students will be able to access Flipgrid topics through Canvas Assignments and can have their work graded by the instructor using the SpeedGrader tool. Housing Flipgrid assignments within the Canvas course makes it much easier for students to keep track of their Flipgrid submissions and replies.

1.1 Signing Up and Signing In to Flipgrid

In this section, we will review how to sign in to a Flipgrid account for the first time. Once this account is created, we will examine how to avoid common errors when logging in and showcase what a successful login should resemble. Finally, we will discuss how to create a Flipgrid integration code for a Canvas course.

1.1.1 Navigate to Flipgrid and Login



Navigate to admin.flipgrid.com in the browser's address bar. Once there, select the **Microsoft Login** button. By selecting Microsoft Login, UC credentials can be used to create or sign in to the Flipgrid account.

If prompted, enter a **UC email address**. It is important to use a UC email address when signing in to Flipgrid so that UC single sign on credentials can be used to verify the account. After entering a UC email address, select **Next**.



If this is the first time logging in to the Flipgrid account, a prompt to fill in the **Tell us a little about yourself** panel will appear. Enter the required information and then click **Lets Go!**

Note: If prompted to create a new topic after logging in to a Flipgrid account for the first time, **do not create a new topic**. Close any panels that prompt the creation of a new topic if logging in to Flipgrid for the first time.


Upon a successful login, the Flipgrid homepage will appear. Contrary to what most think, **course groups WILL NOT be created using the "Create a Group" button.** The course groups are created when Flipgrid is integrated with a Canvas course. This process will be explained in the next section of this manual.

Do not close Flipgrid. We will be returning to this webpage shortly.

1.2 Creating the Flipgrid Integration

In this section, we will review how to create the Flipgrid integration that will be used in the Canvas course. When creating this integration, it is important to name it according to the specific Canvas course where the integration will be used. A new Flipgrid integration **must be created for each individual Canvas course**, so choosing a descriptive, unique name for each integration will be beneficial for keeping track of which integration is being used for each course.

1.2.1 Open Profile



Once on the Integrations tab, scroll down to the Canvas area and click the **Add New Integration** button.

Note: A new integration for each individual Canvas course must be created for each individual semester! The integration is unique to the specific Canvas course and **cannot** be used in another course or in the same course during a different semester. **New integrations must be created for every single course for every single semester and cannot be reused.**

1.2.4 Create a Canvas Integration

Integration Name
Select **Create** for a *Consumer Key* and *Shared Secret* to add within your Canvas Dashboard.


In the **Integration Name** field, use any name that will be helpful for remembering which course the integration is being used for. Since an integration must be used for each individual Canvas course for each individual semester, it is recommended that the integration name include 1) the current semester 2) the current year and 3) the name of the course.

Once the integration has been named, click the **Create** button.

Note: Keeping the name short will make it easier to identify an integration among the integration list. It is recommended that the semester, year, and course name be written in short form.



1.3 Adding the Flipgrid Application to Canvas

In this section, we will navigate back to the Canvas course where the Flipgrid application will be integrated. Once there, we will copy the **Consumer Key** and **Shared Secret** from the Flipgrid integration that was just created and use it to complete the integration. We will be jumping between the Flipgrid website and the Canvas website, so having these two windows in close proximity to another will make this process easier.

1.3.1 Go to the Canvas Course



1.4 Integrating Your Flipgrid Profile to Your Canvas Course

Once the integration has been used to add the Flipgrid application to the Canvas course, a few more steps have to be taken to pair the application with a user profile. To do this, we will create a Flipgrid course group for the Canvas course. The Flipgrid course group will house all the Flipgrid assignments that students will complete throughout the academic term in the Canvas course.

1.4.1 Switch to Navigation Tab

Scroll through the navigation button options and find **Flipgrid** (it is usually located at the top or bottom of the hidden buttons list). Click the **More Options** button (the button with three vertical dots), then click **Enable**. Finally, click the **Save** button at the bottom of the screen.

Note: If the Flipgrid button has not appeared as a navigation option, wait a few moments and then click the **Refresh** button for your browser. It may take a couple of minutes for Flipgrid to be added to the course after adding it in the previous section.

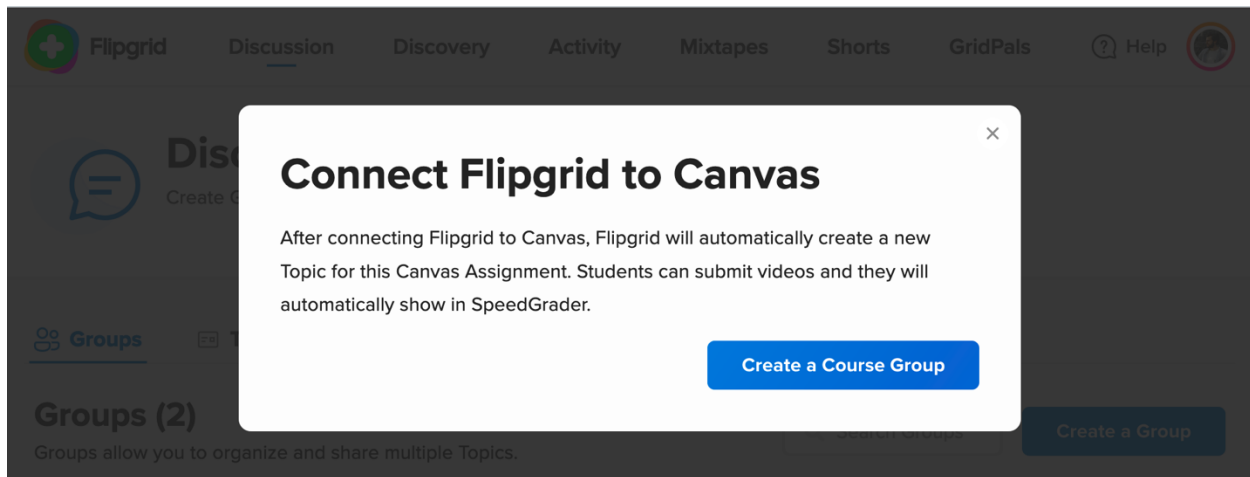

1.4.5 Create Course Group



A window will appear asking to **Create a Course Group**. This will create the Flipgrid course group that will then automatically integrate with the Canvas course. Note that this will only work for a single course. It is not possible to integrate the same Flipgrid group across multiple Canvas courses. Click the **Create a Course Group** button to proceed.

Note: If you have never used Flipgrid before, you may be prompted with a window to “Create your very first grid”. **If you see this, be sure to close it.** After doing so, you will receive the prompt above and can continue with this guide.

After creating the course group, a Flipgrid course page will appear. Instead of seeing “sandbox_camfiemb_001”, you will instead see the full course title of the Canvas course. **Do not create a new topic here.** Creating a topic will be accomplished by using a different method, demonstrated in section 1.5, to ensure that the course Flipgrid assignments link to the Canvas Gradebook.

After creating the course grid, Flipgrid must be removed from the left-hand navigational menu. If students submit their assignments through this link in the left-hand navigational menu instead of through a Canvas assignment, then their submission **will not** sync to SpeedGrader. To remove the Flipgrid button from the navigation menu, 1) click the **Settings** button in the navigation menu, 2) click the **Navigation** tab in the Settings menu, 3) click the **More Options** button located to the right of the Flipgrid navigation button option, and then 4) select **Disable** from the menu. Finally, scroll to the bottom of the page and click the **Save** button.

Once this has been done, refresh the web page to confirm that Flipgrid has been removed from the navigation menu. **Flipgrid should not appear in the left-hand course navigation menu after this step.**

1.5 Editing an Assignment for Flipgrid Submissions

Once the Flipgrid course group has been established, we can then create and edit assignments that will use the Flipgrid application for student assignment submissions. Once Canvas assignments are updated to accept Flipgrid submissions, a Flipgrid topic will be automatically created within the Flipgrid group for the course. In this section, we will review how to edit a Canvas assignment to use the Flipgrid application. Once this step is completed, then Flipgrid will have been successfully integrated with the course!

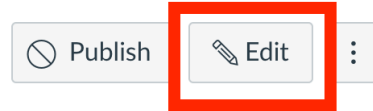

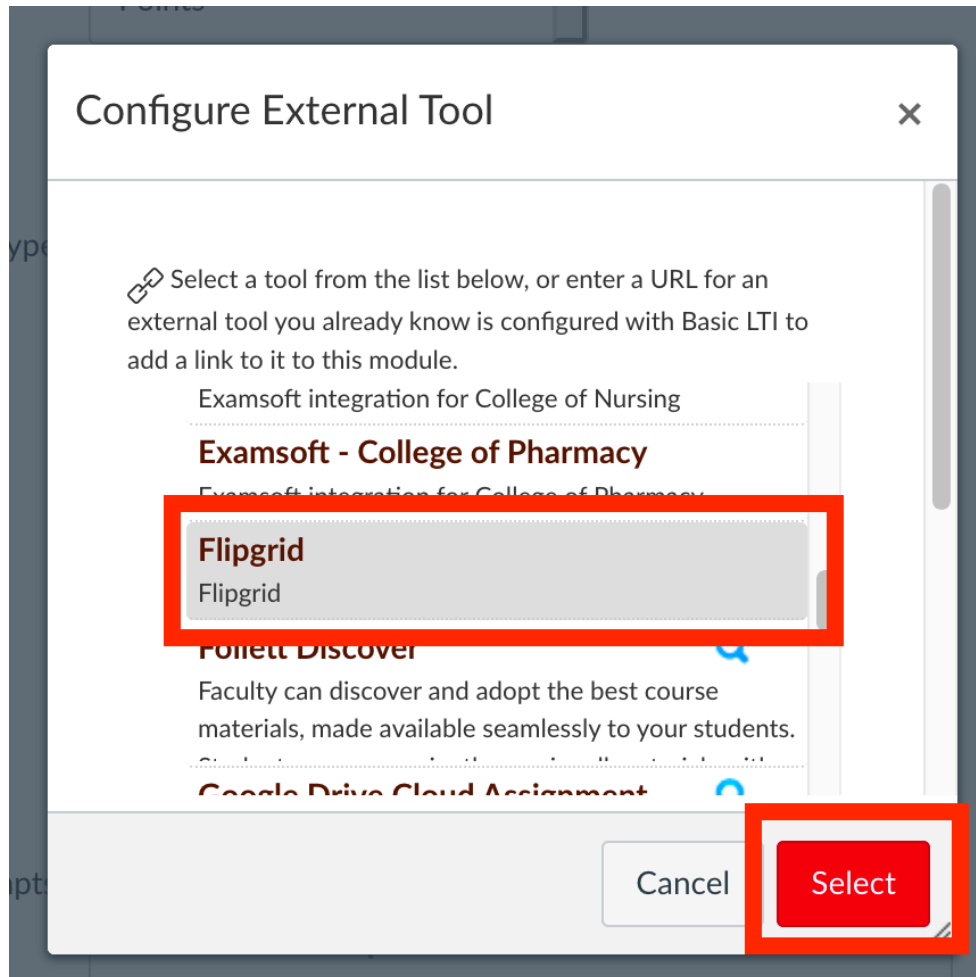


